



SNS GUARDS' RULES

HUMAN RIGHTS POLICY

This policy does not affect your inherent right under International law to self-defense.

SNS LTD PERSONNEL SHALL RESPECT HUMAN RIGHTS AND INTERNATIONAL LAW
AT ALL TIMES

1. Human Rights

You are to respect, uphold and protect human rights at all times.

2. Right to Life

Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person

3. Use of Force

You are to ensure that force is used in reasonable, necessary, proportionate and lawful manner.

4. Treatment

No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment. You must treat humanely all persons taking no active part in hostilities including adversaries who surrendered, are wounded, or are sick.

5. Distinction

You must distinguish between those directly participating in hostilities and any civilian population, so called non-combatants.

6. Civilians and Property

You must avoid unnecessary harm to the civilian population and property

7. Detention and Arrest

No one shall be subjected to arbitrary arrest or detention. Where you are required to detain someone for force protection reasons you must only do so on the authority of the Master. Those arrested or detained are to be released as soon as is practicable or transferred to appropriate authorities.

8. Reporting Abuse

You are to report any suspected abuse of human rights including any unreasonable, unnecessary, disproportionate or unlawful force.
